Dear Vineet,

I am glad to inform that the 4th edition of Pariksha Pe Charcha, the unique interactive program of Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi with students, teachers and parents will be held through online mode in 3rd week of March, 2021 while adhering to the COVID-19 protocols. This event was organized successfully for the last three years by the Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education.

2. We are keen for the schools under your Ministry to become a part of this much-awaited and joyful event. The event will see 2000 selected students directly participating. In order to select 2000 participants for the online event, an online creative writing competition is being conducted at <https://innovateindia.mygov.in/ppc-2021/> on various topics (Annexure-I) during 18th February to 14th March 2021 for children studying in classes of 9 to 12, teachers and parents. All participants will receive a certificate signed by Director, NCERT.

3. The competitions are the mode through which we invite students, teachers, and parents to frame their questions to be addressed to the Hon'ble Prime Minister. Selected questions, shortlisted by NCERT, may feature in the programme. Generally, about 20 to 30 children are shortlisted to pose questions to be answered by Hon'ble Prime Minister. The children who asked questions in the previous editions of Pariksha Pe Charcha are invited by media channels to appear in their programmes. In the same lines this year's chosen few may get an opportunity to interact with media.

4. In this context you are requested to kindly arrange the following:

a. Appoint a Nodal Officer, not below the rank of Director, to liaise with my office for the purpose of this event.

b. Issue instructions to display the creatives (the open files of the creatives will be shared shortly) on:

- ✓ official websites of your organisation and its associate offices,
- ✓ prominent locations in all subordinate offices at various levels,
- ✓ prominent places in all institutions functioning under the aegis of your organisation,
- ✓ during online classes by the teachers.
- ✓ Moreover, you may adopt other innovative measures to propagate and promote this significant initiative of Hon'ble Prime Minister towards reducing exam stress.

c. Ensure all creatives and directions are sent through email and social media to all your students and educational administrators through your office, and through schools to all parents/students.

d. The following hashtags are to be used for disseminating this event: #ExamWarriors and #PPC2021.

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e. Request your students to use their own social media handles and #ExamWarriors and #PPC2021 to disseminate the event, along with their own preparations for the event. Encourage students to make their own posters/creatives/videos, etc. and post accordingly. The selected creatives/videos from among these shall also be exhibited on the MyGov platform.

f. Hold meetings with your Regional Offices within this week to ensure wide dissemination at all levels.

g. Prepare your own media plan for ensuring dissemination and participation.

h. Ensure maximum registration by teachers of NCTE in the online creative writing competition being conducted at <https://innovateindia.mygov.in/ppc-2021/> from 18th February to 14th March 2021 to avail of the chance of being selected for this event.

i. Teachers selected to participate directly in main event of Pariksha Pe Charcha 2021 shall be rewarded with a special kit. This may also be disseminated.


